Weststar Management Corp is proud to announce the adoption of the state-of-the-art document and data delivery system from CondoCerts. CondoCerts provides reliable, round-the-clock online access to all governing documents, budgets, financials, minutes, Rules & Regulations, newsletters and other data for homeowners, real estate agents, bankers, lenders and title companies searching for community documents. Homeowners can continue to obtain their community documents by logging onto www.weststarmanagement.com. The data is now stored in a secure password protected environment. Once you have logged on to the Weststar website all you need to do is:

- Click on the "Residential" picture
- Click on "HOAs" on the upper left green bar
- Click on South Pearl Commons when highlighted
- Click on CondoCerts

If you are a first time user, follow the links to register. Take a note or screen print your user ID and PASSWORD for use as you log in. Your account with CondoCerts will be activated immediately. There is no charge to homeowners downloading and printing out their documents.

A FEW RULESplus

- 1. Hallways No personal items shall be stored or left in the hallways of the Building for any substantial time.
- 2. Large Items All furniture, appliances, bicycles and other large items shall be brought into the Building through the rear door only.
- 3. Pets
 - a. Not more than two common household pets may be kept in any single unit. The owner of each unit in which pets are kept shall be solely responsible for promptly and properly disposing of any pet wastes and for repairing any damage to the common areas or other units of the Building caused by such pets. Each pet owner shall make reasonable efforts to minimize pet noise and odors.
 - b. **Resident Owners only are allowed to have pets** except in a case of which ownership of a particular animal is required by a resident's handicap. No Non-Resident Owner may assign the right to have animals within the Community to any Tenant.
 - c. All owners must have their pets on a leash while in building common

IMPORTANT... It is hazardous and illegal to store propane tanks in the building. Per the Denver Fire Department large 20 lb propane tanks must be kept at least 10 feet away from a condominium combustible structure.



The life expectancy of smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors is generally around 10 years after which time their sensors can begin to lose sensitivity. The test button only confirms that the battery, electronics, and alert systems are working, it doesn't mean the smoke sensor is working. It is recommended that the entire unit be removed and replaced with a new model.



A parking reminder
