







AMERICANA TOWNHOMES - A FEW GAME RULES Trash must be placed in the trash dumpsters throughout the project. Trash must be enclosed in a tightly sealed bag. Boxes must be broken down and placed in a dumpster.

No resident shall permit or suffer anything to be done or kept in the unit which would increase the rate of fire or other insurance thereon or on the project as a whole.

No more than two (2) small (up to 35 lbs each) indoor pets per unit. Pets shall not be chained or tethered outdoors, unattended, so as to become a nuisance to others. Always use a leash when walking your pet and clean up immediately.

Do not feed the wildlife.

Maintain back patio in an orderly and clean manner.

Temporary A/C units and/or window fan units must be removed on or before September 30th to avoid \$50 immediate first fine. (Inspections will take place beginning October 9, 2017).

Any broken windows, windows with grids no longer intact and peeling must be replaced immediately.

Torn or damaged screens and screen doors are replaced by owners. Owners are responsible for the actions of their tenants and fines are levied accordingly

How to Obtain Proof of Insurance and Other Insurance News
