SPRING PROJECTS

- Check and change out batteries to smoke alarm detectors and carbon monoxide alarms.
- Dishwashers and washing machines: drainage lines should be checked for leaks.
- ✓ Check toilets and sinks for a simple drip, drip, drip, leak.
- ✓ Check the water shut off valve to your unit located in the crawl space. You may need a plumber to ensure it is in working order.



YOUR BACK PATIO - 3 IMPORTANT REMINDERS



Trees in the enclosed back patio areas are the responsibility of each owner to remove, trim, and care for. If a tree encroaches on the structure, damage may occur. Any damage resulting from your back patio tree is your responsibility.

If you are planning to refurbish your back patio, install an awning remove pavers, reinstall pavers, relandscape or simply resod the area, remember to submit the architectural form to obtain approval. Your installation may not attach to the fence.



Keep your back patio neat and tidy. Most patios are in the view of your neighbors. A little spring cleaning is always a good idea.
