PARKING

1). AMERICANA PARKING PERMITS Vehicles parked in the parking spaces in front of Americana Townhomes must display the Parking Permit to avoid a boot.

 2). LICENSE PLATES - Ensure you have unexpired license plates on the front and back of your vehicle.
3). PARKING IN GENERAL – Do not park in FIRE LANE, Do not block parking spaces, Park within the lines, Do not claim a visitor space, Visitor parking is first come first served. Your vehicle must be operable. Do not place one motorcycle in a lettered space.
