TRASH REFRESHER

Please be mindful of the trash you place in the dumpster. All trash bags should be securely tied to avoid a spill. No bulk items (Mattresses, furniture, electronics, etc.) are to be disposed of the in dumpster. No construction material, paint or tires should ever be placed in the dumpster. Break down boxes in order to make room for the week's accumulation of trash.

HVAC

The Association is responsible for the operation of the water heater and the boiler that provides heat to the building and the units. This has been a difficult year for the boiler due to corroded pipes that supply the boiler. The unit control valves may need attention following a shutdown of the boiler. If you do run into an issue with your heating, first check with management by calling Jean at 720-941-9200. This repair may be the responsibility of the Association, or it may be something that the unit owner will need to repair. In both cases, Bart's HVAC Service Company is a good call. Bart Lund has serviced the building over the years and has a good handle on problems that may arise. In case you need to contact Bart's HVAC Service, call 303-250-2196 for assistance.

DON'T BE FOOLED

Your garbage disposal cannot handle potato peels, banana peels or fibrous materials like celery stalks and corn husks. Even if the pieces fight their way down the drain, they will probably end up causing a blockage in the building's plumbing and eventually a leak in a lower unit. If that doesn't happen the grease and waste will eventually cause a slow back up in the system. Some things are better disposed of in the trash. A lot of the food items that we often put down the garbage disposal are perfect for compost and Think about it.
