### PET NOISE, PET WASTE, AND PET CARE

At the October Board Meeting a comment was brought to the attention of the Board. Often pet owners allow their dog outside on the back patio for extended periods of time. Sometimes a pet is left out the entire day, barking, whining, and scratching at a back door. Not only is this a disturbance to neighbors but it is disturbing to know the animal has been tethered or simply left out in the cold. Please refrain from tethering a dog outside or leaving the pet for long periods of time alone on the back patio. Do not leave dog food outside as this will attract wildlife. Always clean up after your pet whether the waste is in your back patio area or on common grounds. Pet waste attracts mice and other pests.

**INSURANCE** - The Americana Townhome Association carries a Master Insurance Policy through Wall Street Insurance agent Debbie Harland 970-926-4900. On a regular basis owner lenders request a copy of the Master Insurance coverage and by calling Wall Street Insurance you can obtain a copy of the certificate of Insurance. Please be notified that per a recent insurance inspection owners are reminded of the City of Aurora ordinance on BBQ Grills. No charcoal grills are permitted and when using propane tanks for BBQs they must be ten feet from the building structure when living in multi-family dwellings. If fire damage were to occur and a homeowner's grill found to be the cause, that homeowner's insurance would kick in to cover all damages. Please take this into consideration when purchasing a BBQ grill.
