TRASH DUMPSTERS

When bulk items are left at the dumpster we are charged extra and the cost is often \$300 to \$400 over our monthly budgeted expense.

While you are preparing your holiday meal this year please, be extra careful and do not put large quantities and certain food scraps down the garbage disposal. Potato peels and celery are among the many items that should not go into the disposal. To be safe collect peels and food cuttings in a plastic bag and toss them in the trash. Garbage disposals are designed for small food particles from dishes and pans. Your plumbing system is also inadequate to handle large amounts of food. This can clog up your drains and the drain lines causing backups and other unwanted plumbing issues and the expensive bills for a plumber to come out on Thanksgiving Day.
