FALL WEATHER REMINDERS

It's time to prepare for the colder weather. Before we know it, the temperatures will drop and we will see this season's first snowfall.

Clean up and remove dead or dying flowers in pots. Instead of leaving the pots empty, try covering the soil with pine cones until spring. Tidy up your outdoor area. Cover and protect outdoor furniture.
If you have a hose connected to your outdoor tap it's time to reel it in and store it inside. Plumbing of the exterior spigots is the responsibility of each owner.

• Remove spring and summer décor. Snow shovels can take over the front entry in anticipation of snow.

Check your doors and windows. Replacing weather-stripping on doors and caulking windows inside can help save on energy bills.
Because Colorado is known for warmer temperatures during the day, followed by freezing temperatures at night, ice may develop despite the snow removal efforts. Please be extra cautious when venturing out in the snow and ice.

· Before using your fireplace, inspect and clean the chimney.

POLITICAL SIGNS

Each unit may display no more than one sign per political office or ballot issue. Signs may be posted not earlier than **45 days prior** to the election and may remain **7 days after** the elections. The signs may be no larger than 36 by 48 inches.

SAFETY TIPS

Be careful when tossing personal information (bills, credit card receipts, bank statements, healthcare information, etc.) into the dumpsters. Shred these items to avoid identity theft.
Do not leave packages or valuables in your vehicle and do not leave your vehicle unlocked.
Make sure the doors of your home are locked at all times. If

you have a security system, activate it when away from home.
