Addition to Association's Rules and Regulations, Section 17: Miscellaneous Rules Sub-section K: Community Curfew

It shall be a violation of the Raintree East Rules and Regulations for any person under the age of 18 years to loiter on or about any street, sidewalk, parking lot, outdoor recreation or common area after the hour of 11:00pm or prior to the hour of 5:00am, unless such minor is accompanied by the parent, guardian, or other person at least 21 years of age having permission of the parent or guardian to have custody and care of such minor; or by any person between the ages of 18 years and 21 years having in his or her possession written permission from the parent or guardian to have the care or custody of such minor; provided that on Friday and Saturday nights, the curfew hours for minors under 18 shall be extended to the hour of 12:00 midnight. For the purpose of this section, loitering is defined as remaining idle in essentially one location, to be dilatory, to tarry, to dawdle and shall include, but not be limited to, standing around, hanging out, sitting, kneeling, sauntering or prowling.

It shall be a violation of the Raintree East Rules and Regulations for any parent, guardian, or other person having care or custody of any person under the age of 18 years to allow or permit any such minor to loiter or remain upon any street, sidewalk, parking lot, outdoor recreation or common area after the hour of 11:00pm or prior to the hour of 5:00am, unless such minor is accompanied by the parent, guardian, or other person at least 21 years of age having permission of the parent or guardian to have custody and care of such minor; or by any person between the ages of 18 years and 21 years having in his or her possession written permission from the parent or guardian to have the care or custody of such minor, provided that on Friday and Saturday nights, the curfew hours for minors under 18 shall be extended to the hour of 12:00 midnight. For the purpose of this section, loitering is defined as remaining idle in essentially one location, to be dilatory, to tarry, to dawdle and shall include, but not be limited to, standing around, hanging out, sitting, kneeling, sauntering or prowling.
