### **Restrictions on Feeding Wildlife**

Residents will be required to perform all necessary actions to remove attractants of wildlife. This includes, but is not limited to:

- i) Pet food shall not be put or stored outside for any time period other than the actual time the pet is eating.
- (ii) All barbecue grills shall be cleaned immediately after use and covered.
- (iii) No outdoor bird feeders or hanging bird feeders are permitted.
- (iv) All garbage and trash shall be placed in proper trash bags and well secured prior to placing in the dumpster for trash pickup.

Intentionally placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts all wildlife, including skunks, squirrels, foxes or raccoons and in a manner that is likely to create or creates a public nuisance is prohibited.
