WATCH OUT BELOW

It is time to plant spring and summer colors with the warmer weather and, to enjoy the pleasures of sitting out on the balcony. Please take a moment to tidy up your balcony, remember it is not to be used for storage and our open balconies are viewed from afar. Don't allow water to drain from balconies. When watering plants, washing the balcony or like activities, contain water to your own balcony taking every precaution to avoid water from dripping down onto the neighbor's balcony below.

If water is allowed to drain it makes a dirty mess on the balconies below and often on the cars below in the parking lot.

DOGS ON LEASH AND UNDER CONTROL!

Pets must be on leash and under the control of the pet owner or pet walker while in or on any Common areas: hallways, lobby, stairwells, elevators, building entrances, any garage/parking deck. Pets are not permitted in the Community/ Billiard Room, fitness center, back patio/back yard and laundry room. No pet may be leashed or confined to any stationary object in a Common Area. No pet may be housed or permitted to eliminate on balconies. No pet may use the Common Area sidewalks, patio or backyard for waste elimination. There is a limit of two dogs per unit. The unit owner of the pet is responsible for immediate clean up and sanitation of any area soiled by the pet. The owner will be responsible for the cost of any

damage to Common Area by pet.
